Housing Benefit Change in Circumstance App

Hambleton District Council has recently released a phone app that will allow you to report a change in your circumstance if you are in receipt of Housing Benefit and/or Council Tax Reduction. Changes in circumstances should be reported promptly. This app will enable you to notify us directly of any changes of circumstance at a more convenient time for you. This is available now via your Apple iStore or your Google Play Store and search for Hambleton FERIS. This is free to download.
