Additional Opportunities created by Sports Premium Funding:

- Participation in the Thirsk Schools Cluster inter-school games for football, girls football, Quicksticks hockey (Y3/4 + Y5/6), Swimming, cross-country, tag-rugby, Sports hall athletics, Kwik Cricket and Quad kids
- 3 x Outdoor Table tennis tables to enrich sport provision and table- tennis clubs to teach pupils how to play
- A range of additional extra-curricular sports clubs funded by Sports Premium (see table below)
- Teacher development opportunities to work alongside high-quality sports coaches to develop practice and support sustainability (+ use of ipads to support quality of teaching –reflection, analysis, developing of performance)
