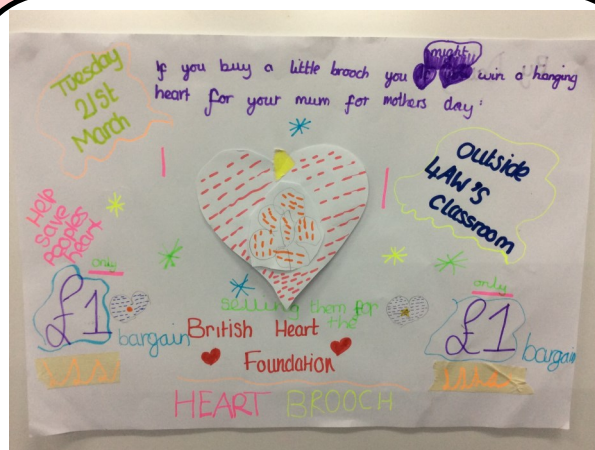
The buns and cakes will be then sold after school to help raise further funds for Red Nose Day
