

I hope that everyone in our school community is keeping well and safe during this period of partial school opening. Under current Governmental guidelines we have now been given greater freedom to welcome children back to school where there is capacity. However, whilst operating within current guidance relating to class sizes and keeping everyone safe, there is currently very little capacity to accommodate additional pupils with the majority of bubbles now running at full capacity.

So for the time being we are restricting pupils returning to school to children in Nursery, Reception, Year One and Year Six. If you have a child in these year groups wanting to return to school please contact the office. However as already stated above there is now very limited capacity, with many bubbles already full. Last week we shared the criteria we would use when allocating places for you to refer to. So as we move further in to the summer term home learning will continue to be an important part of learning for many pupils, please encourage your child to engage with this. If you need any further support or have queries please contact Mrs Turner who is leading home learning, her email address is: homeworkteacher@thirsk-prin-yorks.sch.uk. If and when guidance changes I will update you accordingly.

Please also be aware that in the event of an staff sickness a bubble may need to shut. This is as there is little capacity for covering bubbles, in this event we would try and contact parents at the earliest opportunity. At present there we are not planning to open school over the summer holidays.

On Friday 26th June we will be sending end of year reports for children in Reception to Year Six. For those pupils who are currently in school reports will be given to these pupils to take home along with any siblings that may not be in school. For those families where no children are attending school you will be able collect you child's report on Friday 26th June from the school office. This will be in the time slots below:

As always thank you for you support during this period of time. No doubt in the coming weeks there will be further Governmental announcement and further changes made. I will try to keep you informed of how these will impact you and your children.
