### Holiday Club 2021



After much thought and consideration our team of children's workers from the local churches have decided to make a few changes to how we organize our annual holiday club. We are aware that restrictions are likely to be lifted on 19<sup>th</sup> July but that does not mean Covid will just disappear and our priority is to make sure we offer a safe environment for children and leaders when we meet in person for a fun time hearing bible stories, making crafts, singing, using creative prayers and having messy games. The holiday club is suitable for all children who attend primary school.

We have organized a marquee which will have open sides allowing fresh air to flow through, it will be set up on the field next to the Parochial Hall, all our activities will be held in here rather than inside the hall, we can access the hall for use of toilets and kitchen when necessary.

The biggest change will be that we are only accepting up to 20 children each day so booking is essential, places will be given to a first come, first served basis. If there are spaces available you can book your child in for more than one session. Each session will be from 10am-12noon. We are planning to set up a facebook page so children can access stories & clips on the days they are not attending.

On Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> August we hope to invite families to join us for a picnic at 12noon to share a grand finale of the week on the field, more information about this will be available nearer the time.


