Safeguarding News

Thank you to the parents that came along to the safeguarding meeting earlier this week. During the meeting we discussed safeguarding in school. The potential further development of the field to the rear of the school was also discussed and how the school is going to make sure that this building (if and when it happens) does not impact on the children's safety. The new arrangements for pupils accessing Reception classes via the outdoor area was discussed and if we could ask parents to try and stand to the side to allow access on to the main playground. We discussed whether children were able to talk about how to keep themselves safe especially whether children and parents have a good understanding of eSafety and whether they are able to apply the skills that they are taught in school to real life situations. Finally there was a discussion about arrangements at lunchtime and making sure children have plenty of opportunities to be active and burn off some energy. Thank you once again for those parents that gave up their time to come. There will be a second meeting in the Spring term -look out for the date in the Newsletter.

Keeping safe before school and after school.

Can I please remind everyone that the beginning of the school day and collection time at the end of the school day are particularly busy times. 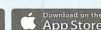
