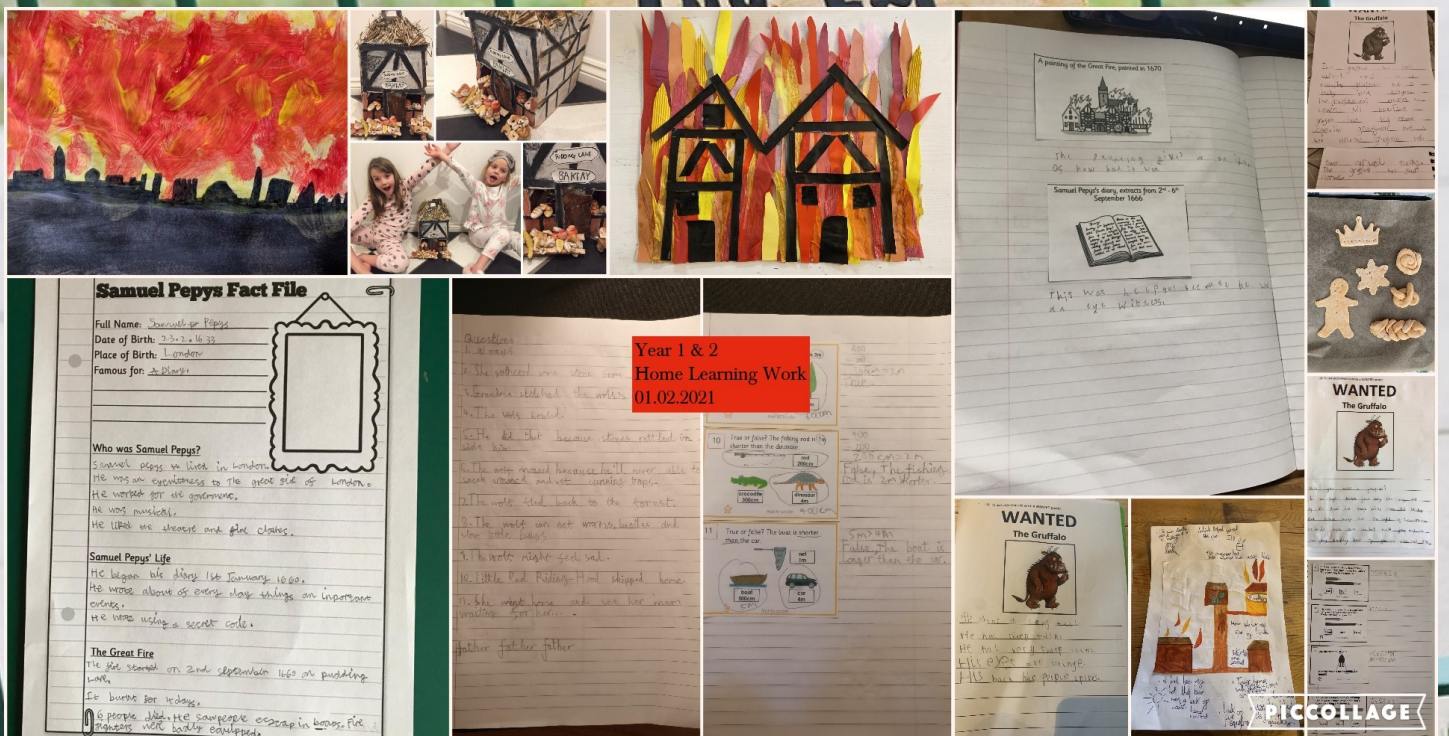

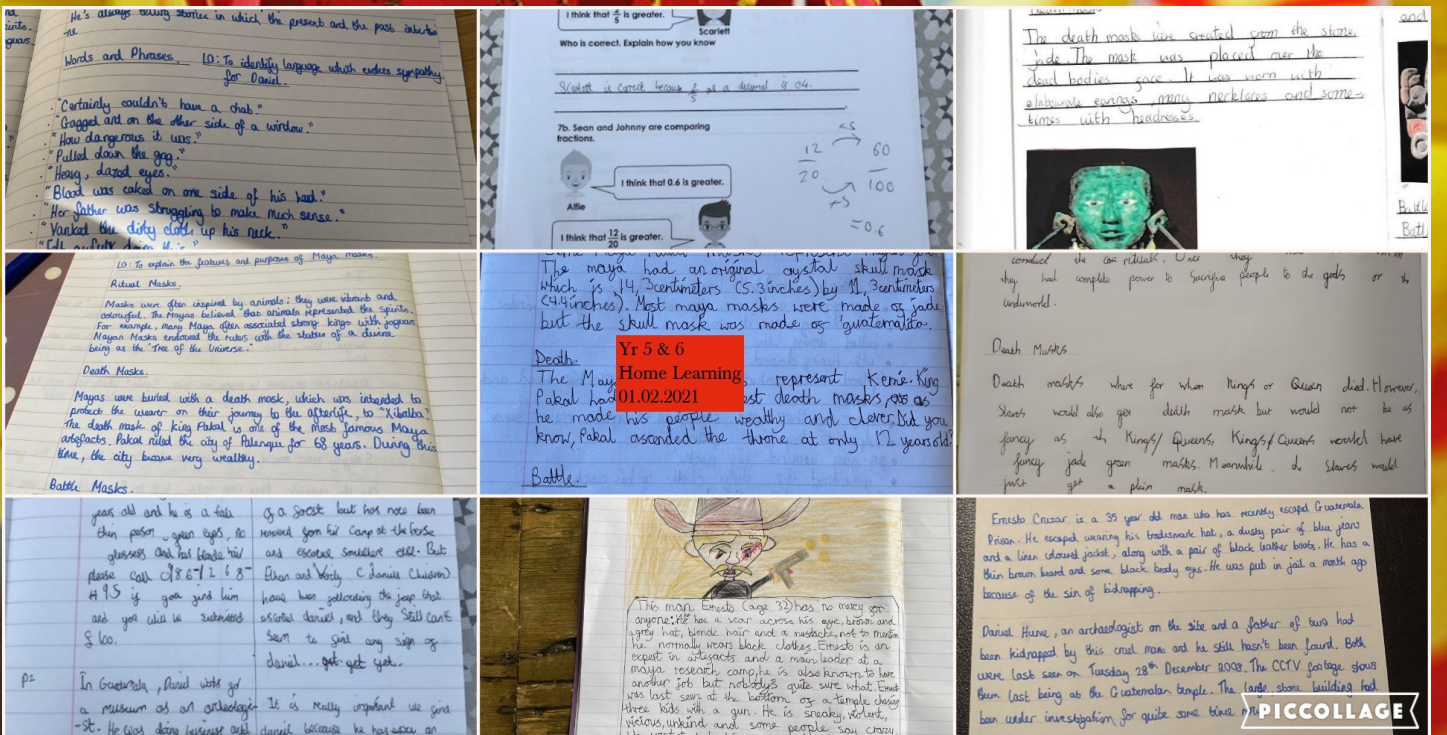
Parents and Carer Questionnaire

Thank you to everyone that completed the Remote learning questionnaire –we have had a really good number of responses to this. Thank you for all the positive comments about our Remote Learning – I have shared these with the teachers– as well as the suggestions for how we can further develop our Remote Learning. One of the key elements that has been identified through the survey is that many parents and carers would like a blended approach to remote learning with some live lessons and some that are pre-recorded. This does vary across the school with parents of the youngest children indicating that pre-recorded lessons and older pupils preferring more live teaching. We will use this feedback as we move towards further developing our Remote Live Learning. Both Miss Gloag and Miss Burrell have been trialling some live teaching and we will be looking at using their expertise to develop this further.
