The popular competition is held annually and is open to all North Yorkshire schools, encouraging all pupils to get creative, and come up with a new design for the bronze, silver and gold medals used for all the County Finals across all School Games Events.

The winning designs is expertly converted into high quality heavy-weight metal medals given to over 2000 participants throughout the year, and pupils are encouraged to consider the values of the School Games, and are influenced by the 'place' of North Yorkshire when coming up with a design.

Development Manager and head judge Jody Ivel said, *'We had hundreds of entries for this year's competition, with a real variety of creative designs representing the ethos of the School Games.
