Mobile Phones

We have updated our mobile phone policy, the following section is for all parents and carers. Please take a moment to read through:

The growth of hand-held mobile technology and interconnectivity has implications for the safety of children, so in order to reflect the policy on safeguarding and child protection, it is essential parents do not use their mobile phones/cameras in the school building and playground area, apart from circumstances as outlined below:

We allow parents to photograph or video special school events such as special assemblies, plays or sports day using their mobile phones or cameras – but insist that parents do not publish images (e.g. on social networking sites) that includes any children other than their own. At the beginning of such events verbal permission will be asked for prior to the event taking place.

We recognise that parents may need phones for communication but ask that while in the presence of children or in public areas of the school such as during meetings and school events, mobile phones/cameras are not on display (switched off or in silent mode)

The full policy is available on the school website and was agreed by the governing body. It will come in to force from Monday 4th June.
