### Protecting Children Against Influenza (Flu) and Complications

The nasal influenza vaccination is being offered to all children in Reception-Year 6. Our team is scheduled to visit Thirsk Community Primary School this Auturn as part of this programme. If you would like your child to receive this immunisation, please ensure your consent form has been submitted no later than 20/09/2019 – if you submit your consent form after this date your child may be missed at school.

Please see below for details of how to consent for your child and answers to common questions about the influenza vaccination programme.

### How do I give my consent?

- 1. Go to www.hdft.nhs.uk/flu-consent

- Click on the link in the grey box which says "Click here for the online consent form."

  Enter the School Code 121365 and click "Find School".

  Complete the form with your child's information and parent/guardian contact information\*.

  Click the green "Submit" button.

\*If you provide a valid email address you will receive an automatic email confirmation to say your form has been submitted. We will also email you to let you know that your child has been vaccinated in school. If your child has specific medical requirements, one of our nurses may need to get in touch before we are due to visit school. We never pass on your contact

### Why is the influenza vaccine being offered?

This vaccination programme is in place to help protect your child against influenza (flu) and stop the spread of the virus within schools, families and the wider community. Influenza is an unpleasant litiness that can lead to school absences and sometimes causes service complications requiring hospitalisation. Vaccinating your child doesn't just project them – by helping to stop the spread of influenza this valuent they will also be protecting vulnerable frends and farmly of all ages.
